

REA FARMS EVENT POLICY

Hours of Operation

Rea Park closes promptly each day at 8pm with the exception of during an event hosted by the property.

Children

Adult supervision (aged 21+) is required for all attendees under the age of 17.

Attendee Conduct

Guests who are found guilty of public intoxication, using profanity/offensive language, throwing objects, or any other perceived misconduct deemed by property management or the Charlotte Mecklenburg Police Department as disruptive or dangerous in nature, are subject to removal from the property.

Costume Policy

There are specific costume guidelines for special events such as Cartoons and Coffee. Before brewing up ideas for your next costume, please take a moment to review our latest rules and regulations:

- Costumes are prohibited for any guest over the age of 14 with the exception of our Halloween event.
- Guests may not pose for pictures or sign autographs for other Guests.
- Costumes must be family-friendly and may not be obstructive, offensive, objectionable or violent.
- Costumes may not contain any weapons that resemble or could easily be mistaken for an actual weapon.

Policies of our third party vendors will also be adopted and adhered to during events. For a full list of policies, please refer to the specific event page at www.reafarmsclt/events.

Guests who do not adhere to these guidelines may be refused entry into, and/or removed from the event, unless his or her costume can be modified to meet the above standards. While we encourage creativity, we also value safety and good judgment. The above costume guidelines apply throughout the duration of Cartoons and Coffee and/or other costumed events. Please note: all rules, regulations and guidelines are subject to change without notice.

Tickets and Refunds

For the enjoyment of the community, Rea Farms events are offered to the public free of charge, unless otherwise noted. For RSVP requirements or ticket information on an event, please visit the individual event page. Refunds may be issued up to 48 hours of the evet start time. Should a need arise for a refund, please call our property management office at the phone number below with your name, phone number, email, and payment information.

Prohibited Items and Security

For the safety and enjoyment of everyone at an event, anyone entering private property is subject to a reasonable search. This includes, but is not limited to bags, purses, coats and hats. Guests are prohibited from bringing the following items onto the property:

- illegal drugs
- knives
- firearms or weapons of any kind
- firecrackers



The property management team reserves the right to restrict any other items that could pose a safety hazard or restrict the enjoyment of another guest. The Charlotte Mecklenburg Police Department also reserves the right to inspect personal belongings of a suspicious nature.
